NOTICE OF REGATTA

2010 LABOR DAY INVITATIONAL REGATTA

MARSHALL BEACH TOMALES BAY

Saturday, September 4, through Monday, September 6

Per Boat pre-registration fee is \$45
On-the-beach registration is \$50 per boat.

There is a camping fee (\$25 for up to six people) for those camping but not paying the registration fee. The fee for one day of racing is \$25.

To qualify for the regatta, a yacht must complete a written entry form. **Pre-registration entries should be mailed by the deadline of Aug. 20 for those ordering shirts; and Aug. 28 -if not.** Beach registration, at \$50 per boat, will be available from 10:30 to 12:00 on Saturday (9/4). Pre-registered yachts must check in during this same time period. At the discretion of the Race Committee, late entries may be accepted up to the first race Sunday Sept. 5.

THE RACING RULES OF SAILING, as published by U.S. SAILING ASSOCIATION, for 2009 -2012 will be used for this regatta. Wearing PFDs is mandatory while racing. A 15 ft towline is suggested. Sailors on centerboard boats should wear wetsuits as the water is dangerously cold. Don't forget this is a Coast Guard jurisdiction, and an equipment check is a possibility. The Coast Guard Auxiliary may be present Saturday and Sunday. **All attendees are advised that the Santa Rosa Sailing Club will not provide rescue boat service.**

Those who wish to camp prior to Friday night, or those camping Monday night, will have to make their own camping arrangements accordingly. (Contact Pt. Reyes National Seashore Headquarters at Bear Valley.) The Santa Rosa Sailing Club cannot make reservations beyond the group permits already obtained (100 campers including children-for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights).

Since the shirts will be embroidered on order by sizes, it is necessary to meet the August 20 pre-registration date for those ordering shirts. We anticipate limited extra shirts for beach sale.

Those who wish to bring items for the Saturday 6:00 o'clock evening hors d'oeuvres party on the beach, we welcome your participation.

At Miller Park overnight parking is on the upper level only.

For those used to launching at Marconi Cove, be aware that the property may be posted as "no trespassing" or blocked. The S.R.S.C. does not endorse violating any restrictions on the use at posted property.
