

**NOTICE OF S R S C RACE SERIES
THE 2008 SUMMER SERIES
Spring Lake, Santa Rosa
First Race Day - Sunday, May 11, 1:00 pm**

CLASSES:

The races will be held as a series of five race days (May 11, June 8, July 13, August 10, and September 14). We expect to have three races per day, for a total of fifteen races. Boats multiplied by races must equal three times the races completed to have a class for the series. Boats not having a class will be scored under the August, 2006, Portsmouth Yardstick D-PN.

SCORING:

To qualify for awards a skipper must participate in 60% of the races completed (nine if all 15 are sailed)

Although anyone is welcome to sail all, or part, of the series, and their scores will affect the series scores of everyone; only S. R. S. C. members will be recognized for the series awards.

Our racing is pretty low-keyed, so even if you have little, or no, racing experience, join us. If you feel intimidated by all this racing "stuff" and "complicated" rules, come early and talk to the race committee person, or bring it up at a meeting; the experienced sailors are always helpful (even if you beat 'em).
